

In October 2016 we introduced the

# Here's what our leaders said about their qualifications & the impact it has had on them...

- 98% improved communications skills
- 96% learnt to work in a team
- 98% felt they could lead others
- 94% believed they were more employable
- 78% said it helped get their first job
- 87% were more inspired to get more people engaged
- 83% wanted to do more in the community
- 68% believed their qualification improved attainment in other subjects
