The course has been designed to cover the required elements of this qualification, whilst also including those aspects which primary school teachers and Head Teachers often tell us they need guidance on to ensure their pupils receive a progressive, broad and balanced Physical Education curriculum.

Who is it for?

The course is open to teachers, higher level teaching assistants, teaching assistants (extensive experience delivering across all years) and coaches (a minimum Level 2 NGB award and 5 years experience delivering to KS1 & 2) to assist in raising standards within primary school education.

Cost: £699

The Level 6 aspect of the course is a 2 day bolt on cost at £100 per day.
